## **COUNTY'S ASSISTED HOUSING DEPARTMENT GOES ON-LINE**

*BOONE COUNTY, KY* —The Boone County Assisted Housing Department earlier this month announced residents in need will now be able to apply for assistance on-line. In the past residents seeking assistance would have to come to the Assisted Housing Department during specified office hours to complete an application for the Section 8 Housing program.

The new on-line application can be completed from any computer at any time. The on-line application is an easy, step-by-step way to get your name on the County's waiting list. Applicants must have the names, dates of birth, and Social Security Numbers available for all household members. You should also know the total amount of income for all household members prior to starting the application.

Ruth Ann Wilson, Director of the Boone County Assisted Housing Department, said, "We are really excited about the new online application process. We encourage applicants to use this new technology, which was designed to simplify and expedite their application process." The ultimate goal of the assisted housing program is to help prevent homelessness and to promote permanent, safe and affordable independent housing in Boone County.
