TRASH FOR CASH PROGRAM AIMED AT KEEPING COUNTY CLEAN *Trash for Cash Program offers money to non-profit groups for trash pick-up.*

BOONE COUNTY, KY — Boone County Solid Waste Division offers program called *Trash for Cash*. This is a program where there are cash incentives available for Boone County non-profit groups who volunteer to pick up trash. The non-profit groups can pick up trash along a mile of roadside and earn \$100 per mile.

"We actually want to keep them on a county road and out of subdivisions," said Kelly Chapman, with Boone County Solid Waste Code Enforcement.

"We keep them where people are actually littering and we can teach the younger kids not to litter," added Chapman.

"It can be a small group or as many as 50, but we do have a limit of 10-miles for the first clean-up and five miles for the second clean up," said Chapman.
