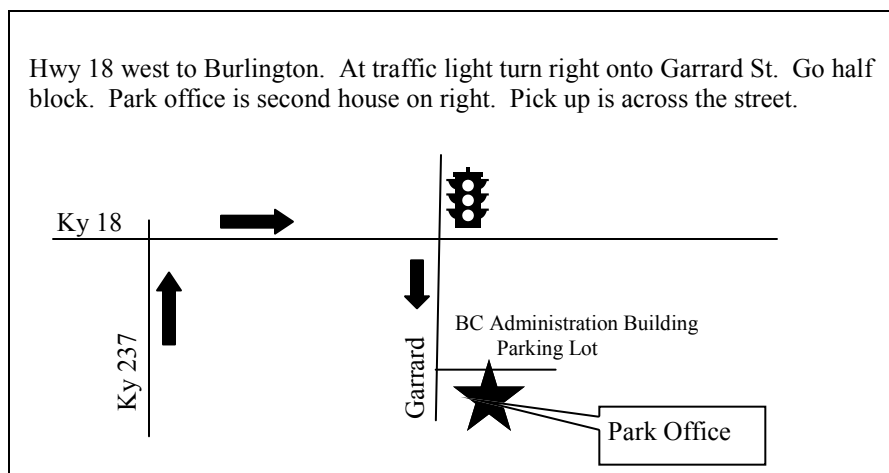

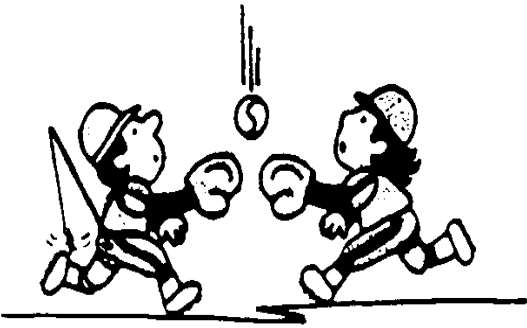

MONDAY NIGHT TEE-BALL PROGRAM
ORGANIZATION & PHILOSOPHY**



-The Tee-Ball program is an instructional league designed for children just entering the baseball world.

-Emphasis is placed on identifying field positions, throwing, and catching a ball, batting, sportsmanship, teamwork and FUN!

-Players will play different field positions each inning.

-All players on the team bat each inning. (Outs count, but are not accumulated.)

-Two or three innings are played. (It varies with the players and generally lasts one hour.)

-Soft, T-ball baseballs and bats are provided by the Parks Department. (We request that children do not bring their own bats.)

-Coaches are Parks Department staff.

-Volunteers are welcome to assist with children on baselines, with those waiting on the bench to bat, and to help the children cheer each other on.

Each team is named after a fish that is native of Kentucky rivers and streams.

With the cooperation of the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife Resources we are giving each player a fish identification book and other items relate to fishing.

At the end of the season we are scheduling a fish outing at Camp Ernst Lake.

-If you would like a longer time frame, more competitive program, there are other baseball organizations in the area.
